Hold any drawing remote to exit [Drawing Mode], and the "1" indicates the machine will return to its original position and the machine is oriented current gameplay page. toward [Position 1].

Cards are jammed during dealing.	Ensure that the cards are flat and not bent.

The machine inconsistently	Check if [Random] mode is ON, which may cause variation in dealt cards per round.
